



Code of Conduct

In an effort to make a more desirable hockey experience for all participants, SLICE is implementing a code of conduct (in accordance with USA Hockey) to be followed before, during and after all practices and games. The violations of this code will be determined and enforced by the coaches and the director of hockey operations. Infractions to the code will incur the following consequences:

1st offense – sit on the bench for 10 minutes

2nd offense – removed from the ice

3rd offense – sit out an entire game (Full equipment, sit with team on the bench)

If a player exceeds 3 offenses, they may be removed from the SLICE hockey program, as determined by the director.

Player's Code of Conduct:

- Play for **FUN**
- **RESPECT** your coach, teammates, parents, opponents, and officials.
- Be a **TEAM** player, get along with your teammates.
- Demonstrate **TEAMWORK, SPORTSMANSHIP, and DISCIPLINE.**
- Work hard to improve your skills.
- Be on time.
- Learn the rules and play by them, always be a good sport.
- Never argue with a coach or an official's decision.

Parent's Code of Conduct:

- Encourage your child to play by the rules.
- Demonstrate a positive attitude towards coaches, officials, players and other parents.
- Emphasize the benefits of skill development and teamwork, de-emphasize games and competition.
- Support a good effort in both victory and defeat.
- Be positive, never verbally or physically abuse your player after a practice or a game.
- Recognize the importance of volunteer coaches.
- Respect, support, and communicate with your coaches.
